SPELLING STRATEGY OF THE WEEK: Each week we highlight a new spelling strategy for you to use to support your child in learning their spellings. These spellings could be the ones sent home by your class teacher or words that your child knows they struggle to spell when writing independently. Little and often is the way to go - 5 or 10 mins per day is far better than 40 mins in one go!

Mnemonics: Mnemonics are ways of remembering the spellings of words by adding a phrase to them. For example: Big Elephants Can Always Understand Small Elephants - helps to spell because. Other mnemonics help you to remember the particularly tricky part of the word you are wanting to spell: would, should, could O U lucky duck - helps you to remember the ould in these three spelling words. There are many mnemonics available online to help you, or you could make up your own. The sillier the better as they will stick in your memory.





Can you think of a better word? Each week we will give you a word and your child's challenge will be to find as many words as they can that mean the same thing. We are looking for adventurous vocabulary. They could find them in the book they are reading, in discussion with other people or in a thesaurus. Please get them to write the words down and bring them in to school to give to their teacher. Can you think any better words for fast?
