

SCHOOL MEALS PRICE INCREASE - Due to the rising costs of fuel, ingredients etc., Lancashire County Council School Meal Service are increasing the cost of school meals to $\pounds 2.50$ per day. This increase will take effect from 1st April 2023.

If you think you may be entitled to free school meals, please follow this link - https://www.gov.uk/apply-free-

<u>school-meals</u> There is no harm in applying! The school receives additional funding for each child on free school meals even if they already receive Universal Free School Meals (infants). This income can be spent on additional support in class for your child, any assessments that may need doing and discounted educational visits. The information is kept confidential.

SPELLING STRATEGY OF THE WEEK: Each week we highlight a new spelling strategy for you to use to support your child in learning their spellings. These spellings could be the ones sent home by your class teacher or words that your child knows they struggle to spell when writing independently. Little and often is the way to go - 5 or 10 mins per day is far better than 40 mins in one go!

Vowel and Consonant colours: Sometimes it can help to build a visual picture or memory of a word. You could give your child the word written down on a small piece of paper and ask them to highlight all of the vowels in one colour and all of the consonants in another colour. Then ask the child to write the word down in two colours of pen. Each time they write a vowel they write it in one colour and the consonants in another. Practise this a few times to help to build the visual memory of the word.







Can you think of a better word? Each week we will give you a word and your child's challenge will be to find as many words as they can that mean the same thing. We are looking for adventurous vocabulary. They could find them in the book they are reading, in discussion with other people or in a thesaurus. Please get them to write the words down and bring them in to school to give to their teacher. Can you think any better words for **small**?
